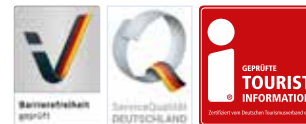

The Kröpelin Gate (Kröpelinertor) is located at the beginning of the shopping street in Rostock's city centre. First mentioned in a document in 1280, it was the most magnificent of the once 22 city and water gates. The six-storey, 54-metre-high building is now a city history meeting centre and houses an exhibition in Rostock's city fortifications.

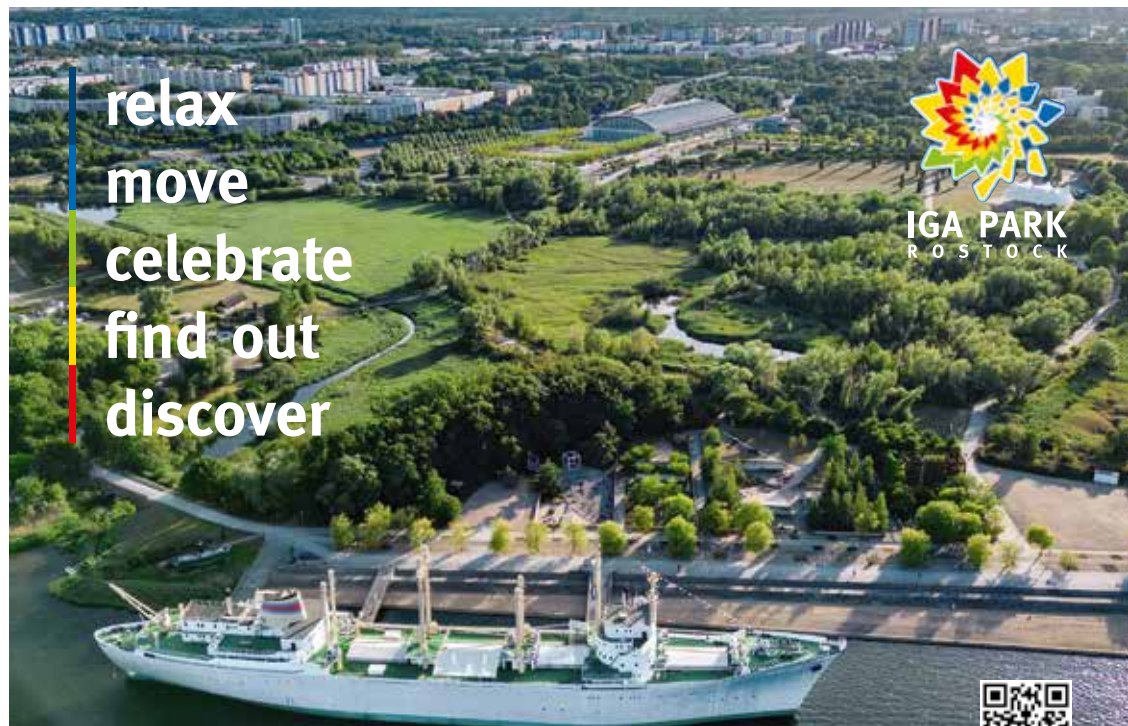

Edvard Munch House

Norwegian painter Edvard Munch (1863–1944) lived in the seaside resort of Warnemünde from May 1907 to October 1908. He recovered from a deep life crisis in the fisherman's house at Am Strom 53, spending 18 extremely productive artistic months here. The house is now listed as a historical monument and is owned by the association Edvard-Munch-Haus e. V. Warnemünde.
