Alexandrinenstraße, used to be called Achterreeg (back row), together with "Am Strom", is one of the oldest streets in Warnemünde. It owes its present name to the famous Louise, Queen of Prussia. The small gabled houses, in which once fishermen, sailors and pilots used to live, are still real eye-catchers today. The fountain of the "Warnemünder Umgang" with its 19 bronze figures is also worth seeing.

It has been at one time a king's palace (1250), a royal bailiwick and manor, seat of the Swedish and French bailiffs and the seat of the town bailiff (1605). Norwegian painter Edvard Munch (1863-1944) lived in the seaside resort of Warnemünde from May 1907 to October 1908. He recovered from a deep life crisis in the fisherman's house at Am Strom 53. spending 18 extremely productive artistic months here. The house is now listed as a historical monument and is owned by the association Edvard-Munch-Haus e. V. Warnemünde. Nowadays, artists from various art directions from Germany and Norway, live, paint, write and make music here and present their works to the public. The association also presents changing special exhibitions and lectures by contemporary artists.
